Western Region Health Centre (WRHC) provides a range of health and community support services in the western region of Melbourne, including a comprehensive mental health program which comprises of home-based outreach, day programs, day to day living programs, Personal Helpers and Mentors Programs (PHaMS), Prevention and Recovery Care Service (PARC) and a Young Persons Residential Rehabilitation program (Rocket).

Rocket provides intensive support to young people aged 16-24 with mental health issues and associated complex needs. WRHC's mental health programs have developed culturally specific programs, strong consumer participation and consumer led models, and have a Mental Health Promotion focus.

We are seeking an motivated, enthusiastic and experienced professional to work as a Community Mental Health Worker (Weekend Shift) in our Rocket program, based in St Albans. The position is ongoing 0.2 EFT (1 day per week) and requires working one Saturday and one Sunday every second weekend.

Experience in and/or understanding of residential service provision in health or community services, particularly mental health, is required for this role, as is a relevant tertiary or equivalent experience and a current Drivers Licence and a Working with Children Check.
